Message to the applicant

During my journey toward a PhD, I learned much more about Black girls and women that resonates with me and other Black girls and women. More importantly, was that WE TOO occupy a very unique space in the universe often not appropriately accounted for nor valued. I found that my presence as a Black woman in the room frequently raised the level of discourse and brought a different conversation to the floor that would not have been possible had I not been there.
